Position Summary			
Perform the construction, installation, maintenance, and operation of the electrical distribution			
system. Provide general support for other departments and assist with general duties.			

## **Essential Functions**

- 1. Perform the construction, installation, maintenance, repair, and operation of the electrical distribution system:
  - A. Perform the installation, maintenance, repair, and operation of the primary voltage underground electrical distribution system including: electric cable, transformers, fuse pads, j-boxes, switches, etc...
  - B. Perform the installation, maintenance, repair, and operation of the primary voltage overhead electrical distribution system including: electric wire, poles, transformers, capacitors, switches, etc...
  - C. Perform the installation, maintenance, and repair of secondary services.
  - D. Assist with installation, maintenance, and repair of substation equipment and components.
  - E. Assist with the operation of substation switches and control equipment.
  - F. Participation in electric department on-call program.
- 2. Perform the following general duties:
  - A. Perform residential customer electric meter disconnects, reconnects, and installations.
  - B. Assist with electrical underground cable and fault locating.
  - C. Operate and maintain construction vehicles and equipment.
  - D. Operate all small hand tools and hand/power equipment.
  - E. Snow removal and general grounds maintenance.
  - F. Other duties as assigned.
- 3. Performs other essential job duties.
  - A. Regular and timely work attendance.
  - B. Follows all safety procedures.
  - C. Participation in safety training.

- D. Participation in industry training
- E. Participation in apprenticeship program and training.

## Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

- Knowledge of electrical distribution systems.
- Knowledge of bucket trucks and other fleet and construction equipment.
- Ability to climb electric distribution power poles with no fear of heights.
- Ability to efficiently use computer, word processing and spreadsheet software, phone, copier, and other standard office equipment.
- Ability to learn and use computer software applicable to essential functions.
- Ability to make decisions within policy and position parameters.
- Ability to accurately and timely complete reports.
- Ability to work independently.
- Ability to communicate effectively.
- Ability to professionally interact with supervisors other employees.
- Ability to interact with customers in a courteous and efficient manner.
- Ability to perform all required physical work which may include sitting, standing, stooping, kneeling, crouching, walking, or crawling.
- Ability to drive assigned vehicles up to 90% of the time.
- Ability to work approximately 10% of the time in an office environment.
- Ability to work approximately 90% of the time in the field.
- Ability to frequently lift 50 lbs.

## **Minimum Qualifications**

- High school degree or equivalent.
- One year vocational training in lineworker program.
- Possess a valid Minnesota driver's license with the ability to obtain and maintain a Minnesota Class A license within 1 year.
- Live or relocate within 20 mile radius or 30 minute commute of Elk River Municipal Utilities' Field Services Building.
